

We still have four Divisions. However, due to the withdrawal of West Bromwich (B) (Div 1), Telford (B) (Div 3), and Bushbury (Div 4), we have only 34 teams this

Since the start there have been several boards defaulted and two occasions of a full team default- not a promising beginning. Ongoing attempts are being made to increase the membership of the League via the Express and Star. I regret, however, that the response has been very poor to date.

Junior Congress - Entries were again up on last year, with many entries in the U10 age group. We must endeavour to nurture the interest of these young players in chess, for their benefit, the benefit of the League, and of the County. Gradings –As readers will know, Roger Edwards, for many years MCCU Director of Grading, has now taken over from Chris Howell as the BCF Director of Game Fee and Grading, handing over his MCCU post to John Robinson, formerly MCCU Events Director.

It is good to know the BCF Grading System is in good hands and Roger is confident that the problems with grading last season (e.g. non-appearance of a promised January 1999list and a late August 1999listwith many errors and omissions) can be put right this season. There will not now be a full January 2000 list, but information in January to correct earlier errors, plus a new list limited to juniors will be produced.

One great virtue of the new grading system is that calculation is done centrally, which allows a single assessment to be made for new players, whose games may be played in different parts of the country. It also allows much more scope for the identification of players. The expansion of computer memory over the years means that use of full forenames can be encouraged and the idea of a player's date of birth as the ultimate identity check has been introduced. New players may get multiple entries onto the database, with each entry short of the minimum number of games to allow publication unless they are credited to a distant namesake! To take full advantage of the new system, the grader needs a computer with at least the Windows 95 operating system, which the present Wolverhampton League graders currently do not have at their disposal. John Robinson has therefore agreed through the MCCU to handle grading of Wolverhampton & District League results for the current season.

Club secretaries can help by sending details of the full name and date of birth of each of their players to the editor, as soon as possible.


