The Midland Chess Clubs received an invitation, on behalf of the British Chess Federation, to host a stand at the BBC East, Live event, held at the NEC Birmingham, 27 – 29 November 1998

The purpose of this event was aimed mainly, but not exclusively, at an Asian audience, encouraging participation in British business and sporting activities. It is, of course, a national objective to encourage people to join chess clubs and take an active part in organised or friendly games. The primary aim therefore was to recruit new members to our local Midland Chess Leagues.

The daily events were organised by Alan Ruffle & Ray Dolan, as follows:-

F riday 27 November 1998 – Lightening Tournament, organised by Ray Dolan. This was a friendly event in which over 40 members of the public accepted an invitation to participate. Ray obtained the names and addresses of 28 potential "recruits" to the Midland Chess Leagues as a result of this event.

Saturday 28 November 1998 – Junior Novice Demonstration – Rapid Play. Swiss Tournament, organised by Alan Ruffle. the youngest being just 5 years of age! Thirteen players participated in this event, The event was won by Sabrina Chevannes, who is the BCF under 11 champion. The Mega Mela Trophy was presented to Sabrina by Hazel Ogara, president of the Great Britain Chess Supporters Club. Ray otained the details of 71 potential recruits, from all over Greta Britain.

Sunday 29 November 1998 – BSS Zenith Celebrity Rapid Play Tournament organised by Alan Ruffle and Ray Dolan. Star guest at this event was Thurumurughan Thiruchelvam, who learned to play at the age of 3. He is now 9 years of age, plays for Richmond Junior Club, has a grade of 157, and is the BCF Under 10 Champion. He has participated in world top tournaments and could be a future Junior World Champion or Grand Master. There were six players in this event, which was a 5-round all-play-all tournament. The other 5 players were:-David Anderton OBE -Walsall Kipping Chess Club & Captain of the England Team 1973 – 1993; Sumeet Ghasi and Ameet Ghasi – both Checkmate, and finally, two Warley Quinborne Chess Club players- Jonathan Blackburn – Kidsgorve Chess Club and Wales; Alan Ruffle.
